WINERY VISIT AT THE SHOPS WILLAKENZIE ESTATE

WillaKenzie Estate takes its name from the WillaKenzie soil on which the vineyards are planted. All of their grapes are estate grown using sustainable farming practices. The goal here is single-vineyard expressions—wines that reflect the terroir where the grapes are grown. Winemaker Thibaut Manet will visit the shops and pour his 2008 Pinot Noirs on Saturday, April 16th. This is always one of our best-attended tastings, and a great opportunity to taste the range of individual terroirs from the WillaKenzie Estate property.

A blend of 80% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Cabernet Franc, and 5% Syrah, the Va Piano Bruno's Blend VII shows excellent depth and complexity. The big style of the 2007 vintage adds a bit of juicy red fruit to this wine, making it taste of red currants, pomegranates, and cassis. The tannins are controlled and the finish is long. For the value, this is our wine of the month.

FEATURED WINERY: GRAMERCY CELLARS

At the age of 26, Gramercy Cellars' winemaker Greg Harrington became the youngest American to pass the Master Sommelier Exam. He has used his talent to create wine programs for chefs such as Joyce Goldstein, Emeril Lagasse, and Wolfgang Puck. He discovered Walla Walla wines while working in Brooklyn, and quickly fell in love with the special character that these wines displayed. They were voted 'Best New Winery in 2010' by *Food & Wine* magazine. Two new wines explain why they received this accolade. The 2008 Gramcery Syrah 'Lagniappe' shows white pepper, game, and minerals, and the 2008 Gramercy Cabernet Sauvignon is a cassis and currant filled red that is perfectly balanced.

2008 & 2009 Oregon Pinot Noirs

Use your cellar wisely and stash some 2008 and 2009 Oregon Pinot Noirs. Oregon Pinot Noir is a hot item these days and the tasty, well-priced \$18 to \$25 wines just fly off the shelves. But there is a train wreck ahead. The 2010 vintage was among the most difficult growing seasons ever in Oregon, and the yields will be tiny by comparison with 2008 and 2009. Many producers are saying that quantities will be 30% to 40% of a normal year. Just as the sales reach their highest volume in years, the supply is going to dry up. Now is a good time to stash some extra bottles in the cellar to weather the coming shortfall. Wise buyers will stock up while good values are still available.

2009 PLANETA CERASUOLO

The 2009 Planeta Cerasuolo di Vittoria comes from the beautiful countryside of Dorilli, between the sea and the Iblei mountains. It is the only DOCG in Sicily. The name is derived from 'Cerasa'—cherryin Sicilian dialect, and is made with the indigenous varieties Nero d'Avola and Frappato. It has aromas of cherry, strawberry, and pomegranate, and it is a surprising complement to Alaskan king salmon.
